**Sub:-** Grant of conditional permission to the **Dhanvantari Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Uttar Pradesh, Vill. Chitauli, P.O. Fatehganj(W), Dist. Bareilly-243501, Uttar Pradesh** for UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats in under Section 13A of the IMCC ACT, 1970 for the academic session 2017-18-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's order No. R-12011/24/2015-EP (IM-1) for 2017 dated 28.11.2016 related to admission matter for the year 2016-17 intimating to develop the requisite infrastructure for 2<sup>nd</sup> professional for consideration of the case for the 2017-18 sessions.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 17-18.04.2017 to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to this Ministry.

3. The recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Sub-regulation (4) of regulation 10 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970 & relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC) for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017 (available at Ministry's website <[indianmedicine.nic.in](http://indianmedicine.nic.in)>), it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria as follows:-

- (i) Teachers: 90% eligible teachers, 05 Higher Faculties (Professor/Reader) in 05 Departments in the college, at least 01 teacher in each of 06 Dept. and any 05 part time teachers as per RMS for upto 60 UG seats;
- (ii) Beds in hospital: Minimum 60 beds in hospital of college for UG course in case of upto 60 UG intake capacity;
- (iii) Minimum 120 patients per day in OPD during the year 2016 upto 60 UG intake capacity;
- (iv) 40% bed occupancy for UG College in IPD during the year 2016;
- (v) Equipment and instruments: Minimum 75% of required equipment as specified under the schedule VII of RMS; and
- (vi) Other requirements: as specified in Sub-regulation (4) of regulation 10 of the RMS.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to *grant conditional permission* to the **Dhanvantari Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Uttar Pradesh, Vill. Chitauli, P.O. Fatehganj(W), Dist. Bareilly-243501, Uttar Pradesh** to take admissions for **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course** for the academic session 2017-18 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2018-19:

- i. all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017.
- ii. all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- iii. all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the specified time period and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2018-19.

6. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.


